Requirements to be an accredited "ATRA Instructor"

1. Financial member of the ATRA
2. Has competent skills and experience in their chosen discipline as determined by the Committee
3. Complete "Affinity RideSafe Online Volunteers Induction" course <https://www.affinityequineinsurance.com.au/training/?affiliate=Australasian> and submit certificates.
4. Make application to the ATRA for accreditation. Certification as an approved instructor is at the sole discretion of the Committee
5. An assistant instructor status may be awarded to someone while they await gaining all the requirements.

The ATRA will only endorse training days, clinics or schools that are under supervision of an ATRA accredited instructor.

The Promoter of the training day, clinic or school must also complete the "Affinity RideSafe Online Volunteers Induction" course and, on the day of the event, complete a risk analysis on the equipment being used, condition of the cattle, arena facilities and the ability of each participant.

As part of the ATRA development program, the ATRA may financially support instructors and or promoters in conducting schools on behalf of the ATRA.

Application needs to be made to the ATRA Committee and all proposals will be considered
